<b>Paper and cardboard</b> <b>YES</b> – newspapers, magazines, books; clean paper bags, rolls of cardboard; exercise books, sheets of paper, envelopes, cards; cardboard boxes and cardboard.  <b>NO</b> – paper coupled with other materials such as plastic and aluminium; containers in Tetrapack; paper plates and beakers, dirty paper used to wrap food.	White containers	Twice a week throughout the municipality
<b>Glass</b> <b>YES</b> - glass bottles and containers.  <b>NO</b> – mirrors, light bulbs, ceramic objects.	Green containers	1 Once a week throughout the municipality; Twice a week for users with the highest level of production: shopping centres, bars and restaurants)
<b>Plastic, Tetrapak and Aluminium</b> <b>YES</b> – mineral water and drinks bottles; bottles for personal hygiene and household cleaning products; trays in plastic for foods without residues, small bags, plastic film for packing; containers in Tetrapak (milk, fruit juices, etc.); drinks cans, metal jars.  <b>NO</b> – plastic toys; plastic objects other than containers for liquids (plates, glasses, cutlery, etc.); plastic with food residues; polystyrene	Yellow bags	Twice a week throughout the municipality
<b>Organic waste</b> <b>YES</b> – cooking waste and left-overs both cooked and raw, as long as cold); fruit peels and remains; vegetable peelings, left-over meat and bones; left-over fish and scales; egg shells; tea, chamomile tea and tisan bags and coffee grounds; cut flowers; napkins and paper soiled by food.  <b>NO</b> – hot foods and liquids; dog and cat litter; garden waste (grass, branches and leaves); nappies	Bio-degradable small bags in brown containers	Twice a week throughout the municipality
<b>Non-differentiated waste</b> <b>YES</b> – plastic coated and aluminium coated paper and grease-proof paper; objects in "rigid" plastic (toys, plates and glasses etc); disposable razors, cigarette lighters; porcelain, ceramics, objects in terracotta; tubes of toothpaste and sucklike, nappies; animal litter, polystyrene fragments and trays; video-cassettes, music cassettes, CDs.  <b>NO</b> - all waste not included in differentiated waste.	Transparent bag	Twice a week throughout the municipality
<b>Garden waste</b> such as grass cuttings, dry leaves and trimmings coming from the maintenance of private gardens)	The user must put waste out on the kerb in crates or bundles on the day agreed for pick-up, following booking made by phoning the free green number;  the quantity must not be more than 15 bundles or 15 bags (or, alternatively, 7 bags and 7 bundles).	The service can be booked free of charge and is provided 3 times a week:  If bookings exceed the pre-established number they are postponed to the first working day of the following week.  Alternatively, the waste can be delivered straight to the municipal waste dump.
<b>Bulky waste</b> such as iron and non-iron materials, wooden furniture, other non-recyclable bulky urban waste)	The user must put waste out on the kerb in crates or bundles on the day agreed for pick-up, following booking made by phoning the free green number;  The volume of bulky waste must not be more than 1 cubic meter.	The service can be booked free of charge and is provided 3 times a week:  if bookings exceed the pre-established number they are postponed to the first working day of the following week.  Alternatively, the waste can be delivered straight to the municipal waste dump.
